Si Woo Kim earned his third career PGA TOUR victory at the 2021 American Express

In 2021, Si Woo Kim made eight birdies in the final round en route to victory, which tied his most birdies in a Final Round of his TOUR career.

Hit 59 of 72 greens in regulation en route to victory, marked his third most Greens hit in an event on TOUR at the time and fourth overall in his career.

Kim made every putt inside 10 feet en route to a final round 64 in 2021.

Si Woo Kim ranked first in Greens in Regulation marking the second winner in the last 5 years to lead the field and go onto win The American Express.
