- 1st Led the TOUR in SG: Putting, gaining +0.764 strokes per round on the greens last season

2015 FedExCup champion Jordan Spieth is set to make his third appearance at THE CJ CUP @ SUMMIT and first start of the 2021-22 PGA TOUR season.

- 4** Jordan Spieth has four top-10 finishes in his PGA TOUR season debuts, including a T8 finish at this event to start the 2019-20 season
- 5th** Last season, Spieth ranked Fifth in both Putts Per Round (28.05) and One-Putt Percentage (43.24%)
- 34.54%** Since the 2013 PGA TOUR season, Jordan Spieth has the third-best Birdie or Better Conversion Percentage of any player with 100+ rounds. In this time frame, Spieth converts 34.54% of his greens in regulation into a birdie or better.

Two-time PGA TOUR winner Sungjae Im picked up his second TOUR victory last week at the Shriners Children's Open. Since 2000, Sungjae Im is one of five players who have won the PGA TOUR in their 100th official start.

- 103rd** Sungjae Im moved to second in the FedExCup standings and in the top-30 for the 103rd week on TOUR. In the last four seasons, Im is one of four players who has ranked inside the top-30 of the FedExCup in over 100 weeks.
- 1st** Sungjae Im leads the TOUR in starts (98), Rounds (342), Birdies (1,413), rounds under par (223), rounds in the 60s (181), rounds 67 or better (86) and score to par (-526) since the 2018-19 season
- 2nd** Second youngest winner of the Shriners Children's Open at 23 years and 6 months
- 62** Hit 62 Greens in Regulation en route to victory, marking the fourth event where he has hit 62 or more GIR's (3 of the 4 at Shriners Children's Open)
