TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

Elevation: The Genesis Invitational, hosted by Tiger Woods, is one of three PGA TOUR events with elevated status, along with the Memorial Tournament presented by Workday and the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard. Those three events offer a larger purse (\$12 million; up from \$9.3 million in 2021), an increased allotment of FedExCup points (550 to the winner) and a three-year PGA TOUR exemption for the winner.

World's best: Each of the top 10 in the Official World Golf Ranking are scheduled to compete at The Genesis Invitational. Last season, nine PGA TOUR events featured all top 10 players:

Those tournaments are all either major championships, THE PLAYERS, a World Golf Championships event or FedExCup Playoffs event. The last time the top 10 players all played in a PGA TOUR event that did not fall into one of those categories was the 2007 Wells Fargo Championship (won by Tiger Woods).

Jon Rahm holds the No. 1 position in the OWGR for the 31st consecutive week, but two players can take over the top spot with a win this week (if Rahm finishes worse than solo-fourth): No. 2 Collin Morikawa and No. 3 Patrick Cantlay, who have combined for seven top-10s in seven starts this season. Neither player has been ranked No. 1 previously.

The par-4 10th: No. 10 at Riviera will be the second-shortest par 4 on TOUR so far this season at 315 yards (shortest: No. 14. Sentry Tournament of Champions).

- There were 373 tee shots hit at No. 10 in 2021, with 297 (79.6%) attempting to hit the green
- Of those 297 attempts, just five (1.68%) hit the green
- Of those five, only one ended up within 60 feet of the hole (Harold Varner III, R4, 18'4", made birdie)
 - One eagle was recorded at No. 10 (Sergio Garcia holed a 44-yard shot from the bunker in the first round)

FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

Last time out: Scottie Scheffler earned his first PGA TOUR title, defeating Patrick Cantlay in a playoff with a birdie on the third extra hole to win the WM Phoenix Open. The victory came in Scheffler's 71st career PGA TOUR start at the age of 25 years, 7 months, 23 days. At No. 15 in the Official World Golf Ranking entering the week, Scheffler became the first top-15 player in the OWGR to earn his first PGA TOUR victory since Branden Grace at the 2016 RBC Heritage (entered No. 14). Scheffler moved to No. 10 in the OWGR and No. 4 in the FedExCup with the victory (both career-highs).

Three straight first-timers: There have been five first-time winners on TOUR this season, including one in each of the last three weeks: Luke List, Farmers Insurance Open; Tom Hoge, AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am; Scottie Scheffler, WM Phoenix Open. The last time there were four or more consecutive first-time winners was in the fall portion of the 2017-18 schedule (Ryan Armour, Sanderson Farms Championship; Patrick Cantlay, Shriners Children's Open; Patton Kizzire, World Wide Technology Championship at Mayakoba; Austin Cook, The RSM Classic).

Top players taking the title: The winner of the first 11 events in the 2021-22 PGA TOUR Season entered the week inside the top 60 of the Official World Golf Ranking. The average OWGR position of winners in the fall portion of the season was 31.8, more than 20 spots higher than the previous record since the TOUR went to a wraparound schedule in 2013-14 (53.2, 2013-14). In the fall of 2020, the average winner's OWGR position was 169.8.

PGA TOUR LIVE on ESPN+: New streaming partner ESPN+ features four live feeds per day including Featured Groups, a Marquee Group, Featured Holes, and a Main Feed. More than 4,300 hours of live coverage are scheduled for 2022, more than triple the PGA TOUR LIVE coverage from previous years.

SPONSOR EXEMPTION SPOTLIGHT

The Genesis Invitational has presented the Charlie Sifford Memorial Exemption since 2009, providing an opportunity to a golfer of a minority background to compete in the tournament. Named in honor of Charlie Sifford, the first Black player to compete on the modern-day PGA TOUR, the 2022 exemption was awarded to Aaron Beverly who will make his PGA TOUR debut. The Sacramento State University alum most recently competed on the Advocates Professional Golf Association (APGA) Tour where he won the Fall Series finale at nearby Wilshire Country Club. Beverly will hit the opening tee shot to start the first round.

There are three former Charlie Sifford Exemption recipients in the field: Harold Varner III (2014), J.J. Spaun (2016) and Cameron Champ (2018). The Genesis Invitational is the first of several tournaments to recognize Sifford in 2022 as he would have turned 100 this year (June 2, 2022).
