Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Max Homa earned his second career PGA TOUR victory in his 110th career start at The Genesis Invitational 2021.

- 0** Max Homa joined Bubba Watson (2014) as the only two players since 1990 to win this event at Riviera CC with a bogey-free Final Round.
- +2.20** Max Homa outperformed the field by +2.20 strokes per round from tee to green, his second-best Strokes Gained: Tee-to-Green performance in a PGA TOUR event (4 measured rds).
- 7** Seven of the last nine Genesis Invitational winners ranked Third or better in SG: Tee-to-Green

- 7** Max Homa played holes 15-18 at Riviera CC in seven under for the week, best of any player and tied Phil Mickelson (2009) for the best score to par on these holes by a Genesis Invitational winner since 1983
- 6** Each of the Genesis Invitational winner has been inside the top-two going into the Final Round since 2016
