TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

Florida Swing begins: Beginning with this week's Honda Classic, the PGA TOUR will be conducting tournaments in Florida over each of the next four weeks: The Honda Classic, Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, THE PLAYERS Championship and Valspar Championship.

Looking ahead to Charlotte: With his win at The Genesis Invitational last week, Joaquin Niemann moved from 14 to No. 5 in the International Presidents Cup Team standings. A captain's pick in the 2019 event, Niemann became the first player from Chile to compete in the team competition.

Four players inside the top 10 in the International Presidents Cup Team standings are in the field: Sungjae Im (South Korea/3), Louis Oosthuizen (South Africa/4), Niemann (Chile/5) and Mackenzie Hughes (Canada/7). Niemann will play the first two rounds in a Featured Group with Im and International Team hopeful Lucas Herbert (Australia/19).

The Bear Trap: PGA National's 15th, 16th and 17th holes make up one of the most difficult three-hole stretches on the PGA TOUR. Among non-major courses that have been played in at least seven seasons since the event moved to PGA National in 2007, "The Bear Trap" ranks as the fourth-toughest stretch (+0.638 on average).

FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

Last time out: Joaquin Niemann earned his second PGA TOUR title at The Genesis Invitational, winning wire-to-wire after opening with scores of 63-63. Niemann was the first wire-to-wire winner of the event since Charlie Sifford (1969) and the first on TOUR since Nick Taylor (2020 AT&T Pebble Beach Pro-Am).

Young on the cusp of big tournaments: With a T2 at last week's Genesis Invitational, PGA TOUR rookie Cameron Young moved from No. 113 to No. 53 in the Official World Golf Ranking. Several key dates are approaching for Young to qualify for some of golf's biggest events:

After The Honda Classic	Top 50 OWGR get into THE PLAYERS Championship
After THE PLAYERS Championship	Top 64 OWGR get into the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play
After the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play	Top 50 OWGR get into the Masters Tournament

Young needs a 2-way T19 or better this week to have a chance to qualify for THE PLAYERS Championship.

Top players taking the title: The winner of the first 11 events in the 2021-22 PGA TOUR Season entered the week inside the top 60 of the Official World Golf Ranking. The average OWGR position of winners in the fall portion of the season was 31.8, more than 20 spots higher than the previous record since the TOUR went to a wraparound schedule in 2013-14 (53.2, 2013-14). In the fall of 2020, the average winner's OWGR position was 169.8.

PGA TOUR LIVE on ESPN+: New streaming partner ESPN+ features four live feeds per day including Featured Groups, a Marquee Group, Featured Holes, and a Main Feed. More than 4,300 hours of live coverage are scheduled for 2022, more than triple the PGA TOUR LIVE coverage from previous years.
