Patrick Cantlay earned his fourth career PGA TOUR victory at the 2021 the Memorial Tournament. Patrick Cantlay becomes the seventh multiple winner of the Memorial Tournament (2019 & 2021). Patrick Cantlay defeated Collin Morikawa on the first playoff hole with a 11' 9" par putt on the 18<sup>th</sup> hole.
