## Outlook for the rest of the Championship

- Saturday $16^{\text {th }}$ - Fine and dry for much of the day with warm sunshine. Cloud increasing during the evening which could bring some light rain ( $0-1 \mathrm{~mm}$ ). A good deal of cloud persisting overnight which brings a chance of some light rain at times ( $0-1 \mathrm{~mm}$ ). High: $23^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\left(73^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\right)$ Low: $14^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\left(57^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\right)$. Winds starting light generally from between S and SW, picking up during the day to S-SW $8-12 \mathrm{mph}$, gusts $15-20 \mathrm{mph}$.
- Sunday $17^{\text {th }}-$ A good deal of cloud with some light rain possible at times, more likely in the morning (0-2 $\mathrm{mm})$. Feeling very warm with sunny spells likely to develop. High: $26^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\left(79^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\right)$ Low: $16^{\circ} \mathrm{C}\left(61^{\circ} \mathrm{F}\right)$. SW winds, light early in the day, picking up to $8-12 \mathrm{mph}$ with gusts $15-20 \mathrm{mph}$ during the afternoon.
