Outlook for the rest of the Championship

- **Saturday 16th** – Fine and dry for much of the day with warm sunshine. Cloud increasing during the evening which could bring some light rain (0-1 mm). A good deal of cloud persisting overnight which brings a chance of some light rain at times (0-1 mm). High: 23°C (73°F) Low: 14°C (57 °F). Winds starting light generally from between S and SW, picking up during the day to S-SW 8-12mph, gusts 15-20mph.
- **Sunday 17th** – A good deal of cloud with some light rain possible at times, more likely in the morning (0-2 mm). Feeling very warm with sunny spells likely to develop. High: 26°C (79°F) Low: 16°C (61°F). SW winds, light early in the day, picking up to 8-12 mph with gusts 15-20 mph during the afternoon.
