Outlook for the rest of the Championship

- **Sunday 17th** – Cloudy early in the day with some mostly light rain likely (0-2 mm). Dry through the afternoon and evening with plenty of sunshine and feeling very warm though some cloud making sunshine milky or hazy at times. High: 26°C (79°F) Low: 16°C (61°F). S-SW winds, light early in the day, picking up to 8-12 mph with gusts 14-18 mph during the afternoon and early evening.
- **Monday 18th** – Dry with a good deal of sunshine through the day. Warm though temperatures will be moderated by an E breeze developing during the day. High: 22°C (72°F) Low: 16°C (61°F).
