## **TOURNAMENT STORYLINES**

Season of Championships: THE PLAYERS Championship is the first of five tournaments on the PGA TOUR schedule offering 600 FedExCup points to the winner, along with the four major championships. The field includes 47 of the top 50 players in the Official World Golf Ranking and 109 PGA TOUR winners combining for 418 titles.

Thomas looks for back-to-back titles: Justin Thomas is looking to become the first player to successfully defend a title at THE PLAYERS Championship. The best result by a defending champion of THE PLAYERS is T5 (Jack Nicklaus/1977, Tom Kite/1990, Hal Sutton/2001). In the last six attempts, only one defending champion has finished in the top 50 (Webb Simpson, 2019). Thomas, a 14-time TOUR winner (most recent came at THE PLAYERS in 2021), has successfully defended a title once on the PGA TOUR (2016 CIMB Classic) and has earned multiple titles at three different PGA TOUR events.

Scheffler coming in hot: With his win at last week's Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, Scottie Scheffler moved to No. 1 in the FedExCup standings for the first time in his career. Three players have won the week before THE PLAYERS and then won THE PLAYERS: Raymond Floyd (1981), Tom Kite (1989) and Tiger Woods (2001).

## **FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES**

**New FedExCup leader:** Scottie Scheffler won last week's Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, his second victory in his last three starts, to take over the No. 1 position in the FedExCup standings. Hideki Matsuyama had held the top spot for seven consecutive weeks before Scheffler's victory. In the FedExCup era, only one player has entered THE PLAYERS Championship No. 1 and won THE PLAYERS: Tiger Woods in 2013.

Youth movement: For the first time, all of the top five in the Official World Golf Ranking (est. 1986) are younger than 30.

First-time winners: Seven players have earned their first PGA TOUR victory this season, including five in the last six weeks. Most recently, Ryan Brehm won the Puerto Rico Open in his last start on his Minor Medical Extension, retaining PGA TOUR status and securing it through the 2023-24 season. Two players have won their first PGA TOUR title at THE PLAYERS: Craig Perks (2002) and Tim Clark (2010). 34 players in the field this week have not won on the PGA TOUR.

**Top players taking the title:** With his win at last week's Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, Scottie Scheffler became the highest-ranked player in the Official World Golf Ranking to win on the PGA TOUR this season, entering the week at No. 6. In all, eight of the 19 PGA TOUR events this season have been won by players who began the tournament in the top 25 of the World Ranking. 23 of the top 25 players in the OWGR are competing this week at THE PLAYERS (all but No. 12 Bryson DeChambeau and No. 19 Harris English, who are both injured).

PGA TOUR LIVE on ESPN+: The PGA TOUR will once again offer fans a wide variety of video content for the 2022 PLAYERS Championship. Building on the Every Shot Live effort in 2021 and the new media rights agreements, the PGA TOUR team will deliver an All-Access experience for fans. This coverage will include expanded content on ESPN+, GOLFTV powered by PGA TOUR and select international media partners, PGA TOUR owned and operated platforms, and Golf Channel/NBC. In total, PGA TOUR LIVE will produce an estimated 167 hours of coverage across four streams. The complete Every Shot Live package is not currently available in the U.S. in light of new media deals, but regardless, fans will have more content available than ever before.
