Extended forecast – Saturday is forecast to be a high impact weather day as a strong cold front pushes through northeast Florida. This front is expected to arrive between 9am-11am Saturday with a line of strong to severe storms along this front. Once the front passes west/northwest winds will increase to 20-30mph with peak gusts to 35mph. Morning temperatures near 70 degrees will drop dramatically behind the front with temps falling to the 50s by the afternoon. Dry weather is forecast on Sunday with chilly temperatures and gusty north winds. Dry weather is also forecast on Monday.
