### TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

**Longhorn defends his title:** 12-time PGA TOUR winner and 2015 FedExCup champion Jordan Spieth is back in San Antonio to defend his Valero Texas Open title. With the win in 2021, Spieth earned his first on TOUR since the 2017 Open Championship, snapping a winless drought of 82 PGA TOUR starts and 1,351 days. He has never successfully defended a title on TOUR.

**Last chance to qualify:** The only way for any of the 121 players in the field that are not currently eligible to get in to next week's Masters tournament is with a Valero Texas Open victory (R. Bland, J. Day, R. Fowler among those not eligible).

**McIlroy, Matsuyama return:** Rory McIlroy is making his second start in the Valero Texas Open and first since finishing runner-up in 2013. Making just his fifth start of the PGA TOUR season, McIlroy enters the week No. 26 in the FedExCup standings. Hideki Matsuyama, who will defend his title at next week's Masters Tournament, made his tournament debut at the Valero Texas Open a week before winning his first major championship title and finished T30.

**Ancer plays at home:** World No. 16 Abraham Ancer, winner of the 2021 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational, is competing at his adopted hometown event for the fifth time, but first as a PGA TOUR winner (best result to date: T23/2021).

**Another shot for Bland:** Richard Bland, competing on a sponsor exemption, is one of 121 players in the field that can qualify for the Masters with a win this week. Bland advanced to the Round of 16 of last week's WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play where he was eliminated by Dustin Johnson, and would have qualified for the Masters Tournament if he had won that match (via the top 50 in the Official World Golf Ranking).

**Mr. 500:** Nine-time PGA TOUR winner Matt Kuchar is making his 500th PGA TOUR start. The last two players to reach 500 starts were Pat Perez (2021 World Wide Technology Championship) and Steve Stricker (2020 Genesis Invitational).

## FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

**New World No. 1:** Scottie Scheffler won his third TOUR title at last week's WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play, his third victory in his last five starts, to take over the No. 1 position in the Official World Golf Ranking for the first time in his career. Scheffler is the 25th player to hold the World No. 1 title (est. 1986) and sixth-youngest. Jon Rahm had held the top spot for 36 consecutive weeks before Scheffler's victory. Scheffler also holds the lead in the FedExCup standings, becoming first FedExCup leader to win on TOUR (outside of the TOUR Championship) since Justin Thomas at the 2020 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational.

**Youth movement:** On March 6 (and March 13), all of the top five in the Official World Golf Ranking were younger than 30 for the first time (est. 1986). All five players remain in the top five but Patrick Cantlay turned 30\* on Thursday, March 17.

**Top players taking the title:** With his win at last week's WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play, Scottie Scheffler extended the streak of consecutive weeks with a winner that had already won this season to four (Scheffler, Smith, Burns, Scheffler). 11 of the 23 PGA TOUR events this season have been won by players who began the tournament in the top 25 of the Official World Golf Ranking, with the highest ranking by a winner this season coming last week (Scheffler was No. 5 entering the week). Six of the top 25 players in the OWGR are competing this week at the Valero Texas Open, highlighted by No. 8 Rory McIlroy.

**First-time winners:** Eight players have earned their first PGA TOUR victory this season, including six in the last nine weeks. Most recently, Chad Ramey won the Corales Puntacana Championship, becoming the first rookie to win on TOUR since Garrick Higgo at the 2021 Palmetto Championship at Congaree. There are 63 players in the field at the Valero Texas Open that have not won on the PGA TOUR (43.8%). Three of the last four winners of the Valero Texas Open earned their first PGA TOUR title (Kevin Chappell/2017, Andrew Landry/2018, Corey Connors/2019).

**Season of championships:** Cameron Smith won THE PLAYERS Championship, earning his fifth PGA TOUR title and second of the season. At No. 10, Smith became the third consecutive winner of THE PLAYERS Championship to enter the week in the top 10 of the Official World Golf Ranking. After playing in this week's Valero Texas Open, Hideki Matsuyama is set to defend his title at the Masters Tournament, the season's first major championship.
