**Extended forecast** – Fog is expected to form over the Gulf of Mexico tonight with some of this potentially moving onshore. Confidence in dense fog is low. A cold front will approach from the north on Saturday and is expected to push through central Florida Saturday night into Sunday morning. A few showers will be possible along the front with this activity coming to an end by 10am Sunday. The threat for lightning Saturday night is low but can't be ruled out.
