**Extended forecast** – A cold front will push into Central Florida tonight and then clear the area Sunday morning. A few showers can be expected along and ahead of the front, with highest chances for rainfall between 2-8am Sunday morning. With some instability in place, a T-storm can't be ruled out, although the threat is low. Once the front passes, skies are expected to become mostly sunny Sunday afternoon with temperatures reaching the upper 70s. Dry and pleasant conditions will continue into Monday.
