**Extended forecast** – The main concern tonight will be fog development, although latest guidance favors areas to our north for the densest fog. A weak cold front will approach north Florida on Friday and eventually pass-through central Florida Saturday night into Sunday morning. The threat for precipitation likely remains east of I-75 Friday and Saturday afternoon given the prevailing flow. If any rainfall occurs this weekend, it would most likely be along the cold front late Saturday night into Sunday morning.
