Today – Flash Flood Watch Until 1AM Saturday: Scattered showers will begin around daybreak and continue through mid-morning before a steadier rain arrives late morning and continuing through the afternoon. Thunderstorms will be possible late afternoon into the evening hours as a warm front moves close to the area. Rainfall will be heavy at times, especially later today into tonight that could cause localized flooding.

Extended forecast – Areas of rain can be expected Saturday morning with scattered showers continuing during the afternoon as the low-pressure system moves to the south. It will be breezy and cooler with temperatures holding in the mid to upper 50s through the day. Rainfall will be light to moderate times with flooding possible in flood prone areas. Scattered showers will linger on Sunday as the system moves off the coast. Drier weather returns Monday with partly cloudy skies and milder temperatures.
