Defending Champion ShotLink Keys to Victory

Brooks Koepka earned his eighth career PGA TOUR victory in his 145th career start at the 2021 WM Phoenix Open.

Brooks Koepka played holes 13-18 at 15-under for the week, marking the best score to par of any player on the final six holes. His 15-under was the third best score to par on the last six holes by a champion at the WMPO since 1987 (1989 & 2001 Mark Calcavecchia -17/-16).

Brooks Koepka made two eagles in the final round marking the second time (2020 RBC Heritage) he has accomplished this feat in his career. His eagle on 17 marked the first eagle made in the final round by a winner of the WM Phoenix Open.
