## TOURNAMENT STORYLINES: WGC-DELL TECHNOLOGIES MATCH PLAY

**Match play:** The 64-player field is broken down into 16 groups of four. Round-robin group play takes place Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, with players receiving one point for a win and half a point for a tie. The player with the most points in each group advances to the Round of 16 (ties broken by sudden-death playoff), and a single-elimination tournament Saturday and Sunday determines the champion. The event is one of three official FedExCup events that does not use the traditional 72-hole stroke-play format, along with the Zurich Classic of New Orleans (2-man team event) and the Barracuda Championship (Modified Stableford).

**Seasoned veterans:** Kevin Kisner and Matt Kuchar have each won 16 matches since the tournament moved to Austin Country Club in 2016, tied for the most of any player in that span. Kisner, the 2019 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play champion, is the No. 29 seed and is grouped with Justin Thomas, Marc Leishman and Luke List (Kuchar not in field). Sergio Garcia (28-22-1) has played in 51 matches, the most in tournament history, and is the 43rd seed (Group 2).

**DeChambeau's return:** Eight-time PGA TOUR winner Bryson DeChambeau is making his third start on TOUR this season and first since the Farmers Insurance Open in January (MC). DeChambeau (No. 209 in FedExCup standings) has made two starts at the event, compiling a 2-4-0 record, and has failed to advance from group play in either appearance.

**Last man in the field:** Eligible players for the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play are the top 64 in the Official World Golf Ranking as of March 13, 2022 (Sunday after THE PLAYERS Championship), with the alternate list beginning with No. 65 on the same date. Six players in the top 64 are not competing (Cameron Smith, Rory McIlroy, Hideki Matsuyama, Sam Burns, Harris English and Phil Mickelson). Maverick McNealy, World No. 70 as of March 13, is the last man in the field.

## FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

**FedExCup leader:** Scottie Scheffler won his second TOUR title at the Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard three weeks ago, his second victory in a three-start stretch, to take over the No. 1 position in the FedExCup standings for the first time in his career. Hideki Matsuyama had held the top spot for seven consecutive weeks before Scheffler's victory. Only Tom Hoge and Talor Gooch can overtake the No. 1 position from Scheffler, who holds the No. 1 spot for the third consecutive week.

**Youth movement:** On March 6 (and March 13), all of the top five in the Official World Golf Ranking were younger than 30 for the first time (est. 1986). The top five remained unchanged after last week's Valspar Championship (**bold** in field), but Patrick Cantlay turned 30 on Thursday, March 17.

**Top players taking the title:** With his win at last week's Valspar Championship, Sam Burns became the third consecutive winner on TOUR to pick up his second win of the season, with his first coming at the Sanderson Farms Championship. In all, 10 of the 21 PGA TOUR events this season have been won by players who began the tournament in the top 25 of the Official World Golf Ranking. 20 of the top 25 players in the OWGR are competing this week at Austin C.C., including seven of the top 10.

**First-time winners:** Seven players have earned their first PGA TOUR victory this season, including five in the last eight weeks. Most recently, Ryan Brehm won the Puerto Rico Open in his last start on his Minor Medical Extension, securing PGA TOUR status through the 2023-24 season. There are 14 players in the field at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play (21.9%) that have not won on the PGA TOUR and 70 such players at the Corales Puntacana Championship (58.3%). There have been four first-time winners at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play (most recent: Ian Poulter/2010) and two in the four-year history of the Corales Puntacana Championship (Brice Garnett/2018, Joel Dahmen/2021).

**Season of championships:** Cameron Smith won THE PLAYERS Championship, earning his fifth PGA TOUR title and second of the season. At No. 10, Smith became the third consecutive winner of THE PLAYERS Championship to enter the week in the top 10 of the Official World Golf Ranking.

## TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

**Name game:** The official name of the tournament was shortened to the Corales Puntacana Championship. The 2022 event marks the first of a four-year extension for the Dominican Republic's first and only PGA TOUR event. The event was played twice in the 2020-21 PGA TOUR Season after the 2020 tournament was postponed to September due to COVID-19, marking the first of three events to be contested twice in 2020-21.

**King of Corales:** All past winners of the Corales Puntacana Championship, including both champions when the event was played on the Korn Ferry Tour (Dominic Bozzelli/2016, Nate Lashley/2017) are back at Corales Golf Course in search of a second victory in the event.

**Field Highlights:** 2020 Corales Puntacana Championship winner Hudson Swafford is the only player in the field that has won on the PGA TOUR this season (The American Express) and can become the fifth multiple winner of the season with a victory. If Swafford wins (or another player that has won this season wins the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play), it would be the fourth consecutive week on TOUR with a champion that had already won this season.

**Sponsor exemption spotlight:** Puerto Rico native and local favorite Rafael Campos will be making his fifth start at the Corales Puntacana Championship and second of the season (T59/Puerto Rico Open). Last season, Campos posted two top-three results on TOUR in a 29-day span with T3 at 2021 Puerto Rico Open and T2 at 2021 Corales Puntacana Championship.
