Things to Know

- Scottie Scheffler wins the World Golf Championships-Dell Technologies Match Play, defeating Kevin Kisner in the Championship Match, 4 and 3
- Scheffler earns his third career PGA TOUR victory, with the first two coming on February 13 (42 days ago) and March 6 (21 days ago)
- With the victory, Scheffler moves to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking for the first time in his career and extends his lead in the FedExCup standings to 780 points
- Corey Conners finishes third with a 3-and-1 victory over Dustin Johnson in the Consolation Match

- PGA TOUR wins: 2022 WM Phoenix Open, 2022 Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, 2022 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play
- Won his first title on February 13 (42 days ago) and his second on March 6 (21 days ago)
- Last player to go 42 days or fewer between first and third PGA TOUR wins: David Duval, 1997 (21 days)
- Three wins in his last five starts on the PGA TOUR

World No. 1

- Moves to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking for the first time in his career
- Becomes the 25th player to reach No. 1 in the OWGR (est. 1986)
- Becomes the sixth-youngest player to reach No. 1 in the OWGR

- Ends Jon Rahm's streak of 36 consecutive weeks as World No. 1

Tournament history

- Record this week: 6-1-0
- Career record at the tournament: 10-2-2 (2nd/2021, Won/2022)
- Youngest winner in tournament history (25 years, 9 months, 6 days); previous: Rory McIlroy (25 years, 11 months, 29 days in 2015)
- First player to win the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play a year after losing in the Championship Match since Kevin Kisner in 2019
- First player to win a PGA TOUR event after finishing runner-up the year prior since Dustin Johnson at the 2020 Masters Tournament
- Advanced from group play after defeating Matt Fitzpatrick in a six-hole playoff; becomes the third consecutive winner of the event to have competed in a playoff following group play
- With a win in the Semifinals over Dustin Johnson, became the sixth player to advance to the Championship Match in consecutive years:
 Scottie Scheffler: 2021, 2022
 Kevin Kisner: 2018, 2019
 Hunter Mahan: 2012, 2013
 Paul Casey: 2009, 2010
 Geoff Ogilvy: 2006, 2007
 Tiger Woods: 2003, 2004

Three-time winner this season

- First player with three wins on the PGA TOUR this season
- First player to win three times in a season on TOUR before the Masters Tournament since Dustin Johnson and Justin Thomas in 2016-17 (three each)
- Fourth consecutive week with a PGA TOUR winner that had already won this season (Scheffler/Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard, Cameron Smith/THE PLAYERS Championship, Sam Burns/Valspar Championship, Scheffler/WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play)
- Extends his lead in the FedExCup standings to 780 points
- Last FedExCup leader to win on TOUR (not including TOUR Championship): Justin Thomas, 2020 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational

Miscellaneous notes

- **Kevin Kisner** becomes the third player to lose in the Championship Match multiple times (2018 and 2022), joining Davis Love III (2004, 2006) and Paul Casey (2009, 2010)
- With his win in the Semifinals, Kisner became the third player to advance to the Championship Match three or more times: Tiger Woods (2000, 2003, 2004, 2008), Geoff Ogilvy (2006, 2007, 2009), Kevin Kisner (2018, 2019, 2022)
- **Corey Connors** defeats **Dustin Johnson** in the Consolation Match, 3 and 1, to finish third; with his win in the Quarterfinals, Connors became the first Canadian in tournament history to advance to the Semifinals
- **Johnson** (4th) earns his second top-10 in his last three starts on the PGA TOUR (T9/THE PLAYERS Championship)
