Things to Know

- Eight of the 16 groups were won by the top seed, tying the most since the group-play format was introduced in 2015
- Three of the four past champions at Austin Country Club in this week's field advanced to the Round of 16 (Billy Horschel, Dustin Johnson, Kevin Kisner)
- Billy Horschel becomes the second defending champion to advance past group play since 2015
- The Round of 16 will feature a rematch of the 2021 Championship Match between Horschel and Scheffler
- 49-year-old Richard Bland becomes the oldest player to advance out of group play since the format was introduced in 2015
- Five players finished group play with a perfect 3-0-0 record
- Three of 11 players making their tournament debut won their group (Richard Bland, Takumi Kanaya, Seamus Power)
