Things to Know

- Scottie Scheffler (2021 runner-up) advances to the Semifinals for the second consecutive year (11th instance of a player doing so)
- Scheffler would ascend to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking for the first time in his career if he wins the tournament
- Two of the four players in the Semifinals have won the event since the move to Austin Country Club in 2016 (Dustin Johnson, Kevin Kisner)
- Kisner has won 21 matches since making his debut in 2016 (most of any player in that span)
- Connors is the first Canadian in tournament history to advance to the Semifinals

- Kevin Kisner (2019) is the only player to win the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play a year after losing in the Championship Match
- Last player to win a PGA TOUR event after finishing runner-up the year prior: Dustin Johnson, 2020 Masters Tournament
- One of four players with multiple victories this season (WM Phoenix Open, Arnold Palmer Invitational presented by Mastercard)
- Last player to win three times in a season on TOUR before the Masters Tournament: Dustin Johnson and Justin Thomas, 2016-17 (three each)

Notes – Dustin Johnson (2017 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play winner)

- Advances to the Semifinals for the second time and first since winning the title in 2017
- Three players have won multiple titles at the event: Jason Day (2014, 2016), Geoff Ogilvy (2006, 2009), Tiger Woods (2003, 2004, 2008)
- Six-time winner of World Golf Championships events, second-most all-time (most: Tiger Woods, 18)
- 24-time PGA TOUR winner (tied for 26th all-time)
- Has won on TOUR in each of the last 14 seasons (2008 through 2020-21), tied with Tiger Woods for the third-longest streak to start a career in PGA TOUR history (most: 17, Jack Nicklaus and Arnold Palmer); can extend his streak to 15 with a victory
- Most recent TOUR victory: 2020 Masters Tournament

Notes – Kevin Kisner (2019 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play winner)

- Improves record at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play to 21-6-1, including wins in 13 of his last 14 matches
- 21 match victories is the most of any player since Kisner made his tournament debut in 2016
- Three players have won multiple titles at the event: Jason Day (2014, 2016), Geoff Ogilvy (2006, 2009), Tiger Woods (2003, 2004, 2008)
- Only player to advance to the Semifinals three times since the group-play format was introduced in 2015
- PGA TOUR wins (4): 2015 RSM Classic, 2017 Charles Schwab Challenge, 2019 WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play, 2021 Wyndham Championship

- Lone PGA TOUR title came in Texas (2019 Valero Texas Open)
- No top-10s in his last 12 starts on TOUR; most recent: T8/2021 FedEx St. Jude Championship (first event of FedExCup Playoffs)
