Things to Know

- Scottie Scheffler defeats defending champion Billy Horschel 1-up in their rematch of the 2021 Championship Match in which Scheffler finished runner-up
- With a win on Sunday, Scheffler would ascend to No. 1 in the Official World Golf Ranking for the first time in his career
- Four players from the top 16 seeds advance to the Quarterfinals (Scheffler, Johnson, Ancer, Koepka)
- Two of the four past champions at Austin Country Club in this week’s field advanced to the Quarterfinals (Dustin Johnson, Kevin Kisner)
- Four players remain with a perfect 4-0-0 record

- Has advanced to the Quarterfinals in each of his two starts at the Dell Technologies Match Play
- With the elimination of Rahm and Morikawa, a win on Sunday would propel Scheffler to No. 1 in the OWGR for the first time in his career

- Power entered the week at No. 48 in the Official World Golf Ranking, 406 spots better than he was this week in 2021

- One year after losing a sudden-death playoff to Kevin Streelman in the third round of Group Play, Ancer advances to the Quarterfinals for the first time in his third career start with a 7-and-6 win over Morikawa
- Seeks to become the third player to win his first two PGA TOUR titles at World Golf Championships events (2021 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational), joining Darren Clarke (2000 Dell Technologies Match Play, 2003 NEC Invitational) and Ian Poulter (2010 Dell Technologies Match Play, 2012 HSBC Champions)
