### TOURNAMENT STORYLINES

**Fun format:** The Zurich Classic of New Orleans, first played in 1938, has featured a two-man team format since 2017 and is the only official FedExCup event on the PGA TOUR schedule that uses a team format. The field consists of 80 teams (160 players), with each team comprised of two professionals, featuring Four-ball (best ball) during the first and third rounds and Foursomes (alternate shot) during the second and final rounds. The 2017 Zurich Classic was the first official team event on the PGA TOUR since the 1981 Walt Disney World National Team Championship held at the Magnolia, Palm and Lake Buena Vista courses at Walt Disney World in Florida, won by Vance Heafner and Mike Holland. (moved to individual stroke-play in 1982).

**Dynamic duo:** 2022 PLAYERS Championship winner Cameron Smith and fellow Australian Marc Leishman return to defend their title. Smith, who won in the inaugural year of the team format (2017) with Jonas Blixt, is the only two-time winner in the team format. Smith leads the Presidents Cup International Team standings, while Leishman is currently No. 12.

**Dream team:** Five of the top-10 players in the Official World Golf Ranking are in the field, but only two of those players are teaming up; World No. 2 Collin Morikawa and World No. 5 Viktor Hovland will compete together, becoming the first pair of top-five players in the OWGR to team up (highest-ranked team since the team format began in 2017, with an average ranking of 3.5).

**Mr. 799:** Nine-time PGA TOUR winner and 18-time PGA TOUR Champions winner Jay Haas will make his 799th PGA TOUR start and first in over a decade as he partners with his son, Bill, a six-time PGA TOUR winner and the 2011 FedExCup Champion. Jay, who last played on TOUR at the 2010 PLAYERS Championship and last made the cut at the 2006 PGA Championship (T68), made 13 starts in the Zurich Classic during his PGA TOUR career, with a runner-up in 1983 at Lakewood Country Club his best result. Jay and Bill Haas are one of 10 father-son duos to win on the PGA TOUR. The last time a father-son duo made the cut in the same PGA TOUR event was at the 2018 RSM Classic (Davis Love III, Dru Love).

**First win coming on the bayou:** Since 1970, the Zurich Classic has had 19 players capture their first PGA TOUR title at the event, the second-most first-time TOUR winners of any active event in that span (most: 23/John Deere Classic). The most recent first time TOUR winner at the Zurich Classic of New Orleans was Cameron Smith in 2017 with teammate Jonas Blixt.

**Ryan's partners:** Since the event moved to a team format in 2017, 2019 Zurich Classic of New Orleans winner Ryan Palmer has teamed up with Jordan Spieth (2017, 2018), Jon Rahm (2019, 2021) and in 2022, Palmer will play with fellow Texas native and World No. 1 Scottie Scheffler for the first time. Palmer's finishes in the event: 2017/4th (Jordan Spieth), 2018/MC (Spieth), 2019/Win (Jon Rahm), 2021/7th (Rahm).

### FEDEXCUP and SEASON STORYLINES

**No. 1:** FedExCup leader and World No. 1 Scottie Scheffler is attempting to win for the fifth time in seven starts. Scheffler earned his first major championship title at the Masters Tournament in his most recent start, becoming the first player since Jason Day in 2015 to win four times in six starts. Scheffler joined Tiger Woods (eight times) as players to win four times in a PGA TOUR season, including a major and a World Golf Championships event. With his third TOUR victory at the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play, Scheffler took over the No. 1 position in the Official World Golf Ranking on March 27 for the first time in his career. Scheffler is the 25th player to hold the World No. 1 title (est. 1986) and sixth-youngest. Scheffler also holds the lead in the FedExCup standings, becoming the first FedExCup leader to win on TOUR (outside of the TOUR Championship) since Justin Thomas at the 2020 WGC-FedEx St. Jude Invitational.

**Youth movement:** On March 6 (and March 13), all of the top five in the Official World Golf Ranking were younger than 30 for the first time (est. 1986). This week, Patrick Cantlay is back in the top five, but has since turned 30.

In the four editions of the Zurich Classic of New Orleans since the team format was introduced, the winning teams have had an age gap of at least eight years. The biggest gap among members of a winning team so far has been 18 years (Jon Rahm/24 and Ryan Palmer/42 in 2019).

**Top players taking the title:** 13 of the 26 PGA TOUR events this season have been won by players who began the tournament in the top 25 of the Official World Golf Ranking (most recent: Jordan Spieth, 20, RBC Heritage), with the highest ranking by a winner this season at the Masters Tournament, where Scottie Scheffler became the first World No. 1 to win a TOUR since 2020.

**First-time winners:** Nine players have earned their first PGA TOUR victory this season, including seven in the last 12 weeks. Most recently, J.J. Spaun won the Valero Texas Open, winning on TOUR for the first time in his 147th career start. Since 1970, the Zurich Classic has had 19 players capture their first PGA TOUR title at the event, the second-most first-time TOUR winners of any active event in that span (most: 23/John Deere Classic). Most recent: Cameron Smith in 2017 with teammate Jonas Blixt.
