STORYLINES - AMERICAN FAMILY INSURANCE CHAMPIONSHIP

Tournament Preview: The sixth annual American Family Insurance Championship is set to get underway with tournament host and Madison native **Steve Stricker** as well as two-time defending champion and local resident **Jerry Kelly** (2019, 2021) leading the star-studded field of 81 players. Past champions in the field also include **Scott McCarron** (2018), **Fred Couples** (2017) and **Kirk Triplett** (2016). Since the inaugural event in 2016, the Steve Stricker American Family Insurance Foundation has provided proceeds of nearly \$12.6 million through 560 charitable grants to the American Family Children's Hospital and other nonprofit organizations.

Players to Watch: Kelly enters the week No. 6 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings following his victory at the Principal Charity Classic last week in Des Moines, Iowa. Kelly, who is seeking his third consecutive victory at the American Family Insurance Championship, has posted four top-10 finishes this season. This week's field also features six of the top 10 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings: No. 2 **Miguel Angel Jimenez** - seven top-10s on the season including two victories at Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualala and Coloquard Classic, No. 3 **Bernhard Langer** - seven top-10s and won the Chubb Classic earlier this season, No. 4 **Stephen Ames** - runner-up at the KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship and five top-10s, No. 5 **Retief Goosen** - six top-10s and won the Hoag Classic in March, No. 7 **Steve Stricker** - won the Regions Tradition and has four top-10s in four starts, and No. 9 **Scott Parel** - three top-10s in 11 events.

Wisconsin Ties: In addition to Kelly and Stricker, other players in the field from the Badger State include **Mario Tiziani** and **Skip Kendall**. Five winners of the former Greater Milwaukee Open/U.S. Bank Championship will also tee it up including **Carlos Franco**, **Jay Haas**, **Billy Mayfair**, **Corey Pavin** and **Jeff Sluman**.
