Things to Know

- The final round began with a special remembrance ceremony, in conjunction with the State of Missouri and Scott Air Force Base, to commemorate the anniversary of 9/11.
- Final round tee times were delayed due to inclement weather at the Ascension Charity Classic presented by Emerson and a two-tee start was implemented. Groups teed off Hole Nos. 1 and 10 beginning at 11:10 a.m. (CST). The leaders started their third round at 1:16 p.m. (CST) off the first tee.
- PGA TOUR Champions coverage on GOLF Channel started at approximately 1:53p (local) and continued through the conclusion of play.
- Projected Charles Schwab Cup No. 2 **Padraig Harrington** carded -14 under (199) in his tournament debut to win the Ascension Charity Classic presented by Emerson.

Padraig Harrington, 65-66-69 - 199 (-14)

- 51-year-old carded his best career-low 54-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions this season (199).
 - Previous best: 200 (2022 DICK'S Sporting Goods Open – Won)
- Earned his third title of the season and joins projected Charles Schwab Cup No. 1 **Steven Alker**, projected Charles Schwab Cup No. 3 **Jerry Kelly** and projected Charles Schwab Cup No.5 **Miguel Angel Jimenez** as the only four players on PGA TOUR Champions with three victories this season.
- Is 3-for-4 at converting when playing in the final group on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Has nine top-10s this season, including four runner-up finishes: Rapisan Systems Classic (T2), Mitsubishi Electric Classic (T2), Regions Tradition (2nd) and The Senior Open Championship Presented by Rolex (2nd).
- His last seven starts include: Win, 2nd, T3, T14, Win, T4, Win.

Y.E. Yang, 68-66-66 - 200 (-13)

- Rookie finished runner-up in his tournament debut at the Ascension Charity Classic presented by Emerson.
- Earned his best finish on PGA TOUR Champions this season.
 - Previous best: T10/2022 The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex
- Posted his best 54-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions this season.
 - Previous best: 206/2022 The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex

- Carded his second-best low 18-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions this season.
 - Previous best:65/2022 The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex

- Charles Schwab Cup projected No. 4 **Steve Stricker** finished third at 12-under (201).
- First-round co-leader, World Golf Hall of Famer and projected Charles Schwab Cup No. 7 **Bernhard Langer** finished fourth at 11-under (202).
- Projected Charles Schwab Cup leader **Steven Alker**, World Golf Hall of Famer and projected Charles Schwab Cup No. 9 **Ernie Els**, **Clark Ennis**, **John Huston** and **Bob Estes** finished T5 at 10-under (203).
- 2021 Champion **David Toms** carded 7-under (206) and finished T16.
- APGA Tour player **Tim O'Neal** carded 3-under (210) to finish T33 in his PGA TOUR Champions debut.
- There were six eagles in the final round.
