Things to Know

- 2020 champion Jerry Kelly and two-time senior major winner Alex Cejka share the lead entering the final round by two strokes over defending champion Steve Stricker and Charles Schwab Cup leader Steven Alker, who each won one of the first three majors of the 2022 season.
- The top 4 players on the leaderboard have combined to win six of the last nine majors on PGA TOUR Champions, dating back to the start of the 2020 calendar year: Cejka (2), Stricker (2), Alker (1) and Kelly (1)

Jerry Kelly, 67-69-65 - 201 (-9)

- This is his ninth time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Is 4-for-8 converting those into victories
 - o Is 1-for-2 in 72-hole tournaments
- Will play in the last group of the final round of the Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS for the third consecutive year
 - Finished 1st (2020) and 2nd (2021)
- Charles Schwab No. 6 will play in the last group of the final round for the second time this season
 - o Finished 4th at the Cologuard Classic
- 55-year-old seeks his 10th win on PGA TOUR Champions (117th start)
 - Has won at least once in each of his five seasons on PGA TOUR Champions
- Seeks his second win of the season (14th start)
 - Won the Principal Charity Classic
 - Would be the third multi-time winner on PGA TOUR Champions this season, joining Steven Alker (3) and Miguel Angel Jimenez (2)
- Seeks his second major win on PGA TOUR Champions (2020 Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS)

Alex Cejka, 64-70-67 - 201 (-9)

- This is his second time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - o Is 0-for-1 converting those into victories
- Will play in the last group of the final round for the first time this season
- 51-year-old seeks his third win on PGA TOUR Champions (33rd start)

- Each of his first two wins were senior majors (2021 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship, 2021 Regions Tradition)
- Making his 14th start of the season, his best finish is T2 (Rapiscan Systems Classic)

Other Notes

- Defending champion **Steve Stricker** sits T3 at 7-under. The Charles Schwab No. 4 looks to become the third player to capture consecutive Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS titles (Bernhard Langer, 2015, 2016; Arnold Palmer, 1985). Stricker, who captured the first major of the season (Regions Tradition), will play in the last group of the final round for the third time in 2022.
- Charles Schwab No. 1 **Steven Alker** sits T3 at 7-under. He seeks his fourth win of the season and second major victory of 2022 (KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship).
- World Golf Hall of Fame member Ernie Els sits fifth at 6-under.
- The four players T6 at 5-under are **K.J. Choi, Rob Labritz, Marco Dawson** and **David Toms**.
