Bernhard Langer, 64-68-68 – 200 (-16)

- Captures 43rd victory on PGA TOUR Champions, two behind all-time leader Hale Irwin (45), at the age of 64 years, 5 months, 24 days
 - Extends his reign as the Tour's oldest winner previously set with victory at the 2021 Dominion Energy Charity Classic (64 years, 1 month, 27 days)
- Becomes the first four-time winner of the Chubb Classic (2022, 2016, 2013, 2011)
 - Went wire-to-wire for the third time (2022, 2016, 2013)
 - Wins have come at three different venues: Tiburon Golf Club (2022), TwinEagles – Talon Course (2016, 2013), The Quarry (2011)
- Extends his run of consecutive seasons with a win on PGA TOUR Champions to 16
- Hit 39 of 42 fairways this week (T5)
- Has made par or better in 40 of 42 rounds at the Chubb Classic
 - Scoring average through six rounds at Tiburon Golf Club's Black Course is 67.16
- Langer is the Chubb Classic's all-time money leader, earning a collective \$1,749,082 in 14 starts
- Moves to No. 2 in Charles Schwab Cup standings with \$292,500 earnings this season (\$106,295 behind leader Miguel Angel Jimenez)
- Six-time Charles Schwab Cup winner (2010, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2018, 2020-21), the most in PGA TOUR Champions history

Tim Petrovic, 66-68-69 – 203 (-13)

- Runner-up finish is his third top-10 at the Chubb Classic in six starts (previous: T4, 2020; T2, 2018)
- 55-year-old has 10 runner-up finishes and 22 top-10s through 102 starts on PGA TOUR Champions
- With his \$140,800 second-place check, moves to No. 5 on the Charles Schwab Cup money list

Other Notes

- Five-time PGA TOUR winner **Brian Gay** cards rounds of 70-67-69 en route to a fourth-place finish in his PGA TOUR Champions debut.
- 2009 PGA Championship winner and South Korean native **YE Yang** posted rounds of 70-67-73 to finish T12.
- 2019 Chubb Classic winner and current Charles Schwab Cup leader **Miguel Angel Jimenez** carded the lowest round of the day with 6-under 66.
- New Zealand native **Steven Alker** posted a T5 finish to notch his 11th top-10 in 12 starts.
- Q-School medalist **Rob Labritz** carded his best round of the week on a Sunday, a 2-under 70 to finish T26 in his PGA TOUR Champions.
