Things to Know

- **Adjusted Final-Round Tee Times:** Due to inclement weather included in Sunday afternoon's forecast, tee times for the final round of the ClubCorp Classic have been adjusted to accommodate the completion of play. Starting at 7:30 a.m. CT, two PGA TOUR Champions players and two celebrities will tee off of No. 1, and at 7:35 a.m., four PGA TOUR Champions will tee off of No. 10. The leaders, including Steven Alker, Lee Janzen, Tony Romo and Mardy Fish will play in the final grouping starting on No. 1 at 9:42 a.m. The initial morning wave will include all 78 PGA TOUR Champions professionals and the top 22 celebrities. The remaining 22 celebrities and 10 ClubCorp amateur members will tee off Holes 1 and 10 starting at 12:30 p.m.
- **Unique format:** The inaugural ClubCorp Classic features 78 PGA TOUR Champions professional golfers and 44 celebrities from sports and entertainment. The PGA TOUR Champions professionals are playing 54 holes of stroke play for a purse of \$2 million, along with the celebrities in a separate \$500,000 competition utilizing a modified Stableford scoring format.
- After starting the day T5, **Steven Alker** enters the final round as the sole leader.
- Former Dallas Cowboys quarterback **Tony Romo** sits in the lead of the celebrity competition with 72 points.

Steven Alker, 68-66 – 134 (-8)

- This is his second time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - 1-for-1 converting into victories (2022 Rapiscan Systems Classic)
- Seeking his third win on PGA TOUR Champions (2022 Rapiscan Systems Classic; 2021 TimberTech Championship)
- With a win, would be the first player since Bernhard Langer in 2017 (Dominion Energy Charity Classic and PowerShares QQQ Championship) to win back-to-back tournaments.
 - Alker won 2022 Rapiscan Systems Classic, the last outing for Champions Tour
- Has 12 top-10s in 15 starts on PGA TOUR Champions, dating back to 2020-21 season
- Sits No. 3 in the Charles Schwab Cup rankings

Lee Janzen, 68-68 – 136 (-6)

- This is his fifth time entering the final round T2 or better.

- 1-for-4 converting these into victories (Won the 2015 Chubb Classic)
- Has one top-10 finish (T3 at 2022 Hoag Classic) in five starts during the 2022 season
- Seeking his third PGA TOUR Champions win
 - Has two wins (2015 Chubb Classic; 2021 SAS Championship) and 27 top-10 finishes since joining PGA TOUR Champions in 2014.

Jerry Kelly, 66-70 – 136 (-6)

- Seeking his ninth win on PGA TOUR Champions, which would give him at least one win in each of his five seasons
- This is Kelly's 13th time entering the final round T2 or better
 - 4-for-12 in converting to victories
- Has two top-10 finishes in five events this season

 - **Brett Quigley**, 69-68 – 137
 - **Tim Herron**, 72-65 – 137
 - **Tim Petrovic**, 70-67 – 137
 - **Woody Austin**, 67-70 – 137

 - **Colin Montgomerie**, 69-68 – 137
- The low round of the day (64) was shot by Monday qualifier, **Mark Hensby** (T26).
- **Tim Herron** carded nine birdies during the second round, most of the day.
- **David Branshaw** had the best back nine of the day with 30.

Amateur ClubCorp Members:

Joining the celebrities and PGA TOUR Champions professionals this week are a select group of 10 amateur ClubCorp members who earned their place in the field through a nationwide qualifying process that included ClubCorp's incredible portfolio of courses and private clubs and culminated at Hackberry Creek Golf Club in Irving on Wednesday. The final 10 players teed it up for two separate competitions this week with five squaring off in a Net Modified Stableford format and the other five in a Gross Modified Stableford format. Both winners will be recognized in the trophy presentation alongside the PGA TOUR Champions and Celebrity winners on Sunday.

Justin Winkler, whose home course is Wildflower Country Club in Temple, Texas, leads the NET competition with a total score of 75. In the Gross division, another local Dallas resident, **Ryan Zamorano**, who the 2005 National Junior College event while playing golf at Paris junior college leads the GROSS competition with a total score of 68. Zamorano is a member at Prestonwood Country Club and plays occasionally in local competitions against celebrity leader **Tony Romo**.
