Extended forecast – Very strong southerly flow is expected to develop tonight into Saturday. Sustained winds likely approach 25 mph by Saturday afternoon with gusts of 35-40 mph possible. Dry conditions likely prevail through the day Saturday, although an isolated shower/T-storm can't be ruled out Saturday night. A slow-moving cold front will approach north Texas on Sunday with an increasing threat for showers/T-storms developing. While there remains model spread, a slower arriving front is favored. This would keep much of the day relatively dry. Rain chances will be kept at 40% for the daylight hours, increasing to 80% Sunday night.
