Otherwise, clouds this morning will eventually give way to partly cloudy skies this afternoon. A late day shower can't be ruled out either, however this threat is very low. A high in the middle 80s is expected.

Extended forecast – A slow moving cold front will approach north Texas tonight. Widely scattered showers/T-storms may develop over West Texas overnight and approach the DFW area Sunday morning. If this activity falls to materialize, it appears much of Sunday could remain dry as the main zone for shower/T-storm development sets up 100-150 miles to the northwest. This activity will eventually sink towards the DFW area but not until after 5-8pm. Showers/T-storms may linger over the area Monday morning before departing. Winds will remain breezy Sunday but will be noticeably weaker compared to Saturday.
