Things to Know

- Charles Schwab Cup leader **Miguel Angel Jimenez** and 64-year-old **Jeff Sluman** share the first-round lead after each shooting 6-under 66.
- Jimenez made a hole-in-one on No. 7, the ninth ace in tournament history. There has been at least one hole-in-one in six of the eight Cologuard Classics contested.

Jeff Sluman, 32-34 – 66 (-6)

- This is his eighth time leading/co-leading after the first round on PGA TOUR Champions (most recent: 2017 Regions Tradition)
- Making his eighth start at this event, his best finish is T6 (2015)
 - Today's 66 matches his best round at this event (2016/Round 2)
- Won the 1997 Chrysler Classic of Tucson, played at Omni Tucson National, on the PGA TOUR
- Owns six wins on PGA TOUR Champions, most recently at the 2014 Big Cedar Lodge Legends of Golf presented by Bass Pro Shops (with teammate Fred Funk)

Miguel Angel Jimenez, 33-33 – 66 (-6)

- The Charles Schwab Cup leader made a hole-in-one on No. 7 with a 6-iron from 193 yards
- Shot 66 or better for the fourth time in 2022 (seven rounds)
- This is his 14th time leading/co-leading after the first round on PGA TOUR Champions (most recent: 2021 American Family Insurance Championship)
- Won the season-opening Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai before finishing T5 at the Chubb Classic in his last start
- Making his fourth start at the Cologuard Classic, his best finish is T5 (2020)
 - Matched his low round at this event (2019/Round 1, 2020/Round 2)
- Owns 11 victories on PGA TOUR Champions, winning at least once in each of his eight seasons (including 2022)
 - Won twice in 2018, 2019 and 2020-21

Other Notes

- Past champions **Woody Austin** (2016) and **Tom Lehman** (2017) are T3 at 5-under 67, along with **Rod Pampling**.

- Tournament host **Jerry Kelly** carded 4-under 68 and sits T6.
- Making his second start on PGA TOUR Champions, Q-School medalist **Rob Labritz** is T6 after shooting 4-under 68.
- **Stephen Ames** recorded the most birdies of the day (9) and sits T6 after carding 4-under 68.
- Winner of last week's Chubb Classic and 2020 Cologuard Classic champion **Bernhard Langer** is T15 after posting 2-under 70.
