Things to Know

- Following his tournament record 8-under 64 in round two, **Steve Stricker** closed with a 3-under 69, his 20th consecutive round of par-or-better, to win the Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS by two strokes.
- **Stricker's** win at Timuquana Country Club marks his 11th career PGA TOUR Champions title and fourth of the season to lead PGA TOUR Champions for most in 2022.
- In his bid for a first top-10 finish in his 16th PGA TOUR Champions start, **Harrison Frazar** (2nd) birdied four of his first five holes en route to the final round's low score, a bogey-free 7-under 65.
- Tournament Host **Jim Furyk** improved on a T4 finish in the inaugural 2021 event with a solo-third in 2022.

Steve Stricker, 69-64-69 – 202 (-14)

- After a T7 finish in the inaugural Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS in 2021, Stricker followed a bogey-free 8-under 64 in round two with a 3-under 69 in Sunday's final round to win by two strokes; marks his fourth win of the season and 11th overall on PGA TOUR Champions (47 starts).
- Stricker becomes the first player to win 11 career PGA TOUR Champions titles in 50-or-fewer starts since Gil Morgan in 1998 (11 victories in 44 starts).
- Stricker's final-round 3-under 69 marks his 20th consecutive round of par-or-better.
- With his win, Stricker moves to 7-for-12 when beginning a final round leading/co-leading (3-for-6 in 54-hole events).
- Stricker's fourth win of the season comes in his 12th start and is his third victory in his last four starts: The Ally Challenge/won, Ascension Charity Classic/3rd, Sanford International/won; his first win of the season came at the Regions Tradition in May.
- With his fourth win, Stricker leads PGA TOUR Champions with the most this season; Steven Alker, Padraig Harrington, Miguel Angel Jimenez and Jerry Kelly each trail with three.
- Stricker becomes the first player to win four times in a PGA TOUR Champions calendar year since Bernhard Langer and Scott McCarron won seven and four times, respectively, in 2017.
- Stricker becomes the first player to win in back-to-back starts since Phil Mickelson (2020 Charles Schwab Cup Series at Ozarks National and 2020 Dominion Energy Charity Classic).

Other Notes

- In his first Constellation FURYK & FRIENDS start, Dallas, Texas native **Harrison Frazar** (2nd/-12) followed scores of 71-68 with a bogey-free 7-under 65 to claim his first PGA TOUR Champions top-10 finish (16 starts); the 65 marked the final-round's low score, as well as Frazar's best lowest score of the season (33 rounds).
- In search of his first win of the season and fourth on PGA TOUR Champions, tournament host and first-round co-leader **Jim Furyk** closed with a second consecutive 3-under 69 to finish solo-third at 11-under 205.
- In his bid for a second win this season (American Family Insurance Championship), Thailand's **Thongchai Jaidee** posted scores of 72-65-69 to finish T4 at 10-under 206.
- Making his PGA TOUR Champions debut, **Notah Begay III** finished T67 at 6-over 222.
- For the fourth time this season, 68-year-old **Jay Haas** (T10/-6) closed with a 5-under 67 to better his age.
- Jacksonville native and son of former Timuquana Country Club head pro, Bob Duval, **David Duval**, finished T72 at 8-over 224.
