Things to Know

- In his tournament debut, **Padraig Harrington** wins the DICK'S Sporting Goods Open, marking his second win and seventh top-3 finish of the season (11 starts); moves to No. 2 in the Charles Schwab Cup
- Thailand's **Thongchai Jaidee** matches the low final-round score of 6-under 66 to claim his seventh top-10 finish of the season and fourth since winning the American Family Insurance Championship in June

Pádraig Harrington – 66-67-67–200 (-16)

- Harrington, who carded back-to-back 5-under 67s in rounds two and three, collects his second career PGA TOUR Champions title just four starts removed from his first at the 2022 U.S. Senior Open Championship
- Harrington's three-stroke margin of victory is the largest since Steven Alker won the KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship by three strokes in May
- With his win, Harrington moves to No. 2 on the Charles Schwab Cup money list (trails Steven Alker)
- With the win, Harrington becomes the fourth multiple winner on PGA TOUR Champions this season, joining three-time champions Steven Alker, Miguel Angel Jimenez and Jerry Kelly
- In addition to his two wins this season, Harrington has amassed five runner-up finishes, most recently at The Senior Open Championship in July
- Harrington's 200 marked his career-low 54-hole score on PGA Tour Champions
- Harrington amassed six career PGA TOUR titles, including the 2007 and 2008 Open Championship and 2008 PGA Championship; most recent TOUR title came at the 2015 Honda Classic

Other Notes

- Highlighted by an eagle-2 at the par-4 16th hole, Thailand's **Thongchai Jaidee** matches the low final-round score of 6-under 66 to claim his seventh top-10 finish of the season and fourth since winning the American Family Insurance Championship in June; the T2 finish comes in his first DICK'S Sporting Goods Open start
- Making his first start at the DICK'S Sporting Goods Open, Canada's **Mike Weir** followed his lowest round of the season, 7-under 65, with a 1-under 71 in the final round to finish T2 at 13-under 203 with Thongchai Jaidee; Weir drops to 0-for-4 when attempting to convert a lead/co-lead into victory heading into the final round on PGA TOUR Champions (won 2021 Insperity Invitational, which was shortened to 36 holes due to inclement weather)
- In his first PGA TOUR Champions start since late June, Monday co-leader **Jim Furyk** closed with a 4-under 68 to finish T4 with fellow North Florida resident Vijay Singh; Furyk was seeking his fourth PGA TOUR Champions crown and first since the 2021 U.S. Senior Open Championship

- World Golf Hall of Fame Member and 18-hole co-leader this week, **Vijay Singh**, closed with a 3-under 69 to finish T4 in his bid for a fifth career PGA TOUR Champions title and first since the 2018 Charles Schwab Cup Championship
- Defending champion **Cameron Beckman** finished T68 at 2-over 218
