Things to Know

- Trailing by four strokes entering the final round, Charles Schwab Cup leader **Steven Alker** posted 8-under 63 en route to a three-stroke win over **Stephen Ames**. It was Alker's fourth win on PGA TOUR Champions, and third win in his last five starts.

Steven Alker, 64-72-69-63 – 268 (-16)

- 50-year-old captures his fourth win on PGA TOUR Champions (19 starts)
 - Earns his third win of the season, most of any player on PGA TOUR Champions in 2022.
 - In his last five starts on PGA TOUR Champions, he has finished 1st-2nd-1st-T3-1st
- Earns his first senior major title (second start)
 - In his senior major debut at the 2022 Regions Tradition, he finished T3.
- This was his fourth win in his last 11 starts, dating back to last season.
 - 2021 TimberTech Championship
 - 2022 Rapiscan Systems Classic
 - 2022 Insuperity Invitational
 - 2022 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship
- Matched the low final round by a champion (63) in KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship history (Paul Broadhurst/2018)
- Has been inside the top 5 after 35 of his 60 rounds on PGA TOUR Champions.
- Earned the 29th win by a player from New Zealand on PGA TOUR Champions.
- This is his 16th top-10 finish in 19 starts on PGA TOUR Champions.

Other Notes

- 54-hole leader **Stephen Ames** finished runner-up at 13-under after carding 1-under 70 in the final round. It is Ames' best finish in a senior major, and the best finish by a Canadian player in a senior major since the inception of PGA TOUR Champions in 1980.

- Looking to win his 12th senior major, 2017 champion **Bernhard Langer** finished third at 10-under. The reigning Charles Schwab Cup winner led the tournament as he made the turn on Sunday, but made three bogeys and a double bogey on the back nine.
- Charles Schwab No. 2 **Miguel Angel Jimenez** finished T4 at 9-under, along with **K.J. Choi**, **Paul Goydos** and **Mike Weir**.
- Looking to become the first repeat winner of the event since 2014-2015, defending champion **Alex Cejka** closed with 1-over 72 to finish 13th.
- PGA professional **Tracy Phillips** (South Central Section) earned low club professional honors with a T17 finish at 5-under.
