Things to Know

- Miguel Angel Jimenez defeated Steven Alker on the second sudden-death playoff hole to win the season-opening Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai.
 - The first playoff hole (No. 18) was tied with pars after Alker missed a birdie putt to win.
 - On the second playoff hole (No. 18), Jimenez made par and Alker failed to get up-and-down for par from a greenside bunker.
 - This was the sixth playoff in tournament history (1987, 1995, 2005, 2013, 2020)
- Jerry Kelly carded the round of the day with 7-under 65, which included 6-under 30 on the back nine.

Miguel Angel Jimenez, 67-66-66 – 199 (-17)

- Becomes the second three-time winner of the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai (2015, 2020, 2022)
 - Bernhard Langer is the other three-time winner of this event (2009, 2014, 2017)
 - Two of Jimenez's three wins at Hualalai came in a playoff, as he defeated Fred Couples and Ernie Els in 2020
- Matches his low 54-hole score at the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai (eight starts)
 - Also posted 17-under 199 in 2015
- Improves to 4-3 in playoffs on PGA TOUR Champions
- 58-year old earns his 11th win on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Has won at least once in each of his eight seasons, dating back to 2014
- Earns the 12th win by a player from Spain on PGA TOUR Champions

Steven Alker, 66-67-66 – 199 (-17)

- Matches his lowest 54-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions (11 starts)
 - Also posted 199 at the 2021 TimberTech Championship and 2021 Charles Schwab Cup Championship
- Notched his 10th top-10 in 11 starts on PGA TOUR Champions
 - In his last three starts, he has finished 1st-2nd-2nd
- Has been inside the top 10 on the leaderboard after 24 of his 34 rounds on PGA TOUR Champions
- Was the lone player in the field without a bogey in regulation

Other Notes

- **Vijay Singh** and **Stephen Ames** finished T3 at 16-under 200 after sharing the lead entering the final round with **Ernie Els** (T6, 14-under 202).
- **David Toms** closed with 6-under 66 to finish fifth at 15-under 201. It was his fourth top-5 in five starts at the Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai.
- Three-time tournament champion **Bernhard Langer** finished T10 at 11-under 205 for his 11th top-10 in 15 starts at Hualalai. It marked Langer's 200th top-10 on PGA TOUR Champions (295 starts).
