#### Things to Know

- Ken Duke and David Toms share the first-round lead after each shooting 7-under 65.
- Toms was one of four players to post bogey-free rounds on Friday, along with **Robert Karlsson**, **Shane Bertsch** and **Steve Jones**.

#### Ken Duke, 32-33 - 65 (-7)

- Carded his lowest 18-hole score of the season (19 rounds)
  - Was his sixth consecutive subpar round (Posted three subpar scores in his first 13 rounds of the season)
- Marks his first time leading/co-leading after the first round on PGA TOUR Champions
  - Previous best: T2 (two times)
- This is his second time leading/co-leading after any round on PGA TOUR Champions (T1/R2/2019 Sanford International)
- Making his third appearance at the Mitsubishi Electric Classic, his best finish is T6 (2019)
  - o Today's 65 was his lowest round at this event
- The 53-year-old is seeking his first win on PGA TOUR Champions
  - Best finish: T2 (2019 Sanford International)
  - o Has nine top-10s in 63 starts on PGA TOUR Champions

## David Toms, 32-33 - 65 (-7)

- Carded his lowest 18-hole score of the season (19 rounds)
  - o Matched his second-lowest opening-round score on PGA TOUR Champions
- This is his seventh time leading/co-leading after the first round on PGA TOUR Champions
- Making his fifth appearance at the Mitsubishi Electric Classic, his best finish is T34 (2017)
  - o Today's 65 was his lowest round at this event
- The 55-year-old is seeking his third win on PGA TOUR Champions

- o Won the 2018 U.S. Senior Open and 2021 Ascension Charity Classic
- o Has 41 top-10s in 103 starts on PGA TOUR Champions
- Has four top-10s in six starts this season on PGA TOUR Champions

- 2018 champion Steve Flesch sits in third after shooting 5-under 67.
- Steve Stricker, who finished T2 in his season debut last week at the Insperity Invitational, birdied four of his first six holes en route to 4-under 68 and sits T4.
- Open qualifier Mark Walker carded 4-under 68 and sits T4, along with Robert Karlsson and Paul Broadhurst.
- Atlanta resident **Billy Andrade** is T8 after posting 3-under 69.
- Matt Gogel made a hole-in-one on No. 16 with a 7-iron from 165 yards.
