STORYLINES - PNC CHAMPIONSHIP

Tournament Preview: The PNC Championship is a two-day, 36-hole tournament that uses a two-person team Scramble format. The event, which began in 1995, was originally named the Father/Son Challenge and intended for professional golfers to play competitive golf alongside their sons. In recent years, the field has expanded to include players' daughters, fathers and grandchildren, and in 2020, the name was changed to PNC Championship to reflect the high level of competition and the field composition while still celebrating the family relationships. A member of each team must have won at least one major or THE PLAYERS Championship title, while the partner must not hold a PGA TOUR card.

The Dalys Defend: Team Daly (John and John II) returns as the defending champions, setting the tournament scoring record (117) last year. Team Daly has finished inside the top 10 in all six appearances at the PNC Championship (2016/T8, 2017/T9, 2018/T2, 2019/5, 2020/8, 2021/1st). They are looking to become the first back-to-back winners of the PNC Championship since Larry Nelson (2007, 2008).

Third Time's the Charm?: Team Woods (Tiger and Charlie) is set to make their third appearance at the PNC Championship after narrowly missing the title last year. Team Woods made 11 consecutive birdies in the final round (Nos. 7-17) en route to 57 and finished runner-up behind Team Daly at 25-under 119. In their debut, Team Woods finished seventh in 2020, shooting 20-under 124.

Playing with dad: Jordan Spieth and Justin Thomas, who recently teamed up to win Capital One's The Match, will each be playing with their dads, Shawn Spieth and Mike Thomas. In addition, Nelly Korda, currently ranked No. 2 in the Rolex Women's Golf Rankings, will be playing with her dad, 1998 Australian Open champion (tennis) Petr Korda.
