Things to Know

• Four players (**Steven Alker, Brett Quigley, Kirk Triplett** and **Jerry Kelly**) share the lead at 13-under entering the final round, with 43-time PGA TOUR Champions winner **Bernhard Langer** trailing by one stroke.

Steven Alker, 67-64 – 131 (-13)

- Matched his lowest 36-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Also posted 131 at the 2021 Charles Schwab Cup Championship and 2021 TimberTech Championship
- This is his fourth time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions.
 - Is 2-for-3 converting those into victories
- Is playing in the last group of the final round for the fifth time this season
 - o Is 2-for-4 converting those into victories
- Charles Schwab Cup leader is seeking his fifth win on PGA TOUR Champions (20th start)
- A win on Sunday would be his fourth victory of the 2022 season.
 - o His three wins are the most of any player on PGA TOUR Champions this season
 - Has gone 1st-T2-1st-T3-1st in his last five starts entering the week
- A win on Sunday would be the 30th victory by a player from New Zealand on PGA TOUR Champions

Brett Quigley, 65-66 - 131 (-13)

- This is his lowest 36-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions
- This is his third time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Is 0-for-2 converting those into victories
- Is playing in the last group of the final round for the first time this season
- Seeking his second win on PGA TOUR Champions
 - o 2020 Morocco Champions
- Making his second appearance at the Principal Charity Classic, he finished T37 in his debut last year

Kirk Triplett, 63-68 - 131 (-13)

Matched his second-lowest 36-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions

- Has posted 129 twice (2021 Charles Schwab Cup Championship, 2017 U.S. Senior Open Championship)
- This is his fifth time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions.
 - He is 2-for-4 converting those into victories.
 - Last lead/co-lead entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions: 2019 Sanford International (finished T7)
- Is playing in the last group of the final round for the first time this season
- Seeking his ninth win on PGA TOUR Champions since joining in 2012
 - Last win: 2019 PURE Insurance Championship
 - Making his 10th start of the 2022 season, he has one top-10 (T6/Cologuard Classic)
- Making his ninth appearance at the Principal Charity Classic, he has three top-10 finishes
 - Best finish: T2 (2012)

Jerry Kelly, 65-66 - 131 (-13)

- Matched his second-lowest 36-hole score on PGA TOUR Champions
 - His lowest is 128 (2019 U.S. Senior Open Championship)
 - This is the fifth time he has posted 131 on PGA TOUR Champions (2021 Mitsubishi Electric Championship at Hualalai; 2017 Pacific Links Bear Mountain Championship, 2017 Shaw Charity Classic, 2017 Boeing Classic)
- This is his eighth time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Is 3-for-7 converting those into victories
- Has three top-10 finishes in four starts at the Principal Charity Classic.
 - Best finish: 3rd (2019)
- · Seeking his ninth win on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Would be his fifth consecutive season with at least one victory since joining PGA TOUR Champions in 2017
 - Last win: 2021 American Family Insurance Championship

Other Notes

- Charles Schwab No. 3 **Bernhard Langer** carded 6-under 66 for the second consecutive day and sits in fifth at 12-under. A win on Sunday would be his 44th victory on PGA TOUR Champions and he would extend his record as the oldest winner on Tour at 64 years, 9 months, 9 days.
- 2017 champion Brandt Jobe is in sixth at 9-under as he goes for his third win on PGA TOUR Champions.
- 2019 champion Kevin Sutherland is one of nine players T7 at 8-under.
