Today – Rainfall yesterday/overnight: 1.60”. A pesky cold front will become stalled out just southeast of Sioux Falls today. A few rain showers are possible this morning (15-25% chance), otherwise dry conditions are favored during the afternoon with clearing skies. Temperatures should climb into the middle to upper 70s. Winds will favor a westerly direction and remain under 15 mph.

Extended forecast – An upper-level disturbance will track along the stalled out front tonight with showers/T-storms possibly moving into the Sioux Falls area between 12-6am Saturday. This activity should be weakening as it approaches, so kept shower/T-storms chances at 35%. Skies likely clear during the day Saturday with dry conditions expected. Southwest winds could gust near 20 mph. Another weak disturbance will pass overhead late Saturday night into Sunday morning with just very light precipitation possible.
