Things to Know

 Making his Ally Challenge debut, Steve Stricker birdied Nos. 13-16 en route to 5-under 67 and a one-stroke victory over runner-up Brett Quigley.

Steve Stricker, 70-64-67 - 201 (-15)

- 55-year-old earned his second win of the season (nine starts)
 - Also won the Regions Tradition
- Becomes the fifth multiple-time winner this season on PGA TOUR Champions, joining Steven Alker (3), Miguel Angel Jimenez (3), Jerry Kelly (3) and Padraig Harrington (2)
- Earned his ninth win on PGA TOUR Champions (44 starts)
 - Marks his fourth consecutive multi-win season
 - Has won 20.4% of his starts
 - Has finished in the top 3 in 52.3% of his starts
 - Has finished in the top 10 in 81.8% of his starts
- Remained No. 5 in the Charles Schwab Cup standings after his fifth top-2 finish in nine starts this season
- Improved to 2-for-4 when playing in the last group of the final round this season

Other Notes

- **Brett Quigley** finished eagle-birdie-birdie on the last three holes to card 4-under 68 and finish runner-up at 14-under. The result matched his best finish at The Ally Challenge (T2/2020).
- **Jeff Maggert** carded the round of the day with 7-under 65 en route to a third-place finish, his best of the season (18 starts).
- 36-hole leader **Scott Dunlap** and Charles Schwab No. 2 **Padraig Harrington** finished T4 at 12-under. It is Harrington's eighth top-5 finish this season (12 starts).
- Each of the four past champions finished in the top 20: 2018 champion **Paul Broadhurst** (T11), 2020 champion **Jim Furyk** (T13), 2019 champion **Jerry Kelly** (T16) and 2021 champion **Joe Durant** (T16).
- Charles Schwab Cup leader Steven Alker finished T9 at 10-under for his 12th top-10 of the season (16 starts).
- John Huston finished T9 to earn a spot into the next Champions Tour event, the Ascension Charity Classic.
