**Today** – Cloudy skies will hang tough through early afternoon as low-level moisture remains across the region. Cannot rule out a few sprinkles or isolated showers developing through mid-day. Otherwise, drier air will overspread the state as we go through the afternoon, helping to break up the clouds and allow for partly cloudy skies to return late in the day. Temperatures will hold in the 60s this morning before warming into the upper 70s by late afternoon.

The chance for scattered showers and thunderstorms will return late Sunday night and continue into Monday as the cold front approaches the region from the west.
