### Things to Know

- **Darren Clarke** sits 8-under with a two-stroke lead entering the third round of The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex.

### Darren Clarke, 65-67 – 132 (-8)

- Tied his lowest 36-hole score in any PGA Tour Champions major (also 2021 Senior Open).
  - Tied for his third-lowest ever 36-hole score on PGA Tour Champions, trailing only 2020 TimberTech Championship and 2021 Mitsubishi Electric (131).
- This marks the fifth time he has led/co-led after 36 holes on PGA Tour Champions.
  - Is 2-for-5 in converting those leads to wins.
- Seeking fourth career PGA Tour Champions win and first career PGA Tour Champions major victory (74<sup>th</sup> start).
- Previous best PGA Tour Champions major finish came in 2021 (3<sup>rd</sup> at The Senior Open).

### Scott Parel, 66-68 – 134 (-6)

- Carded his lowest 36-hole score this season during PGA TOUR Champions major play.
  - Previous best: Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS Championship (69).
- Carded his lowest 36-hole score at The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex.
  - Previous best: R2/71 (2019).
- Seeking his first win at The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex in four appearances.
  - Best finish: T24 (2019).

### David Frost, 67-68 – 135 (-5)

- Sits T3 with seven other players entering the third round The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex.
- His 135 is his lowest ever 36-hole score in any PGA Tour Champions major (56<sup>th</sup> major start).
  - Marks his lowest 36-hole score in any PGA Tour Champions event since 2018 (Shaw Charity Classic).
- Previous best 36-hole position in PGA Tour Champions major is 3<sup>rd</sup> (2013 Senior Open).
- Seeking seventh career PGA Tour Champions victory and second major (won 2013 Regions Tradition).
  - Most recent PGA Tour Champions victory: 2015 Mississippi Gulf Resort Classic presented by C Spire.

### Other Notes

- Seven additional players sit T3 at 5-under 135 entering the third round of The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex.

- **Ernie Els** is making his second appearance and seeking first win this season on PGA TOUR Champions (12 events).
- 2016 Senior Open Champion **Paul Broadhurst** is seeking his second title in five years at The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex and his second major title in three years.
  - Previous: 2018 KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship.
- First round co-leader **Stephen Ames** is seeking his first win on PGA TOUR Champions this season and has six top-10 finishes.
  - Best finish: Runner-up at Senior PGA Championship.
  - Last win: 2021 Principal Charity Classic.
- **Padraig Harrington** is seeking his second major title this season on PGA TOUR Champions.
  - Last win: U.S. Senior Open Championship
- Four-time Senior Open champion **Bernhard Langer** seeking first win since earning the 2019 title.
- **Jerry Kelly** is seeking his first win at The Senior Open Championship presented by Rolex. (4 events)
  - Best finish: 6<sup>th</sup>/2020.
- PGA TOUR Latino America player **Miguel Angel Martin** is seeking his first major title.
- Charles Schwab Cup leader **Steven Alker** registered a 4-under 136 and stands T11.
- Reigning Senior Open champion **Stephen Dodd** sits T47 entering the third round.
