#### Things to Know

- Darren Clarke birdied No. 18 to win the 2022 Senior Open Presented by Rolex, a one-shot victory over Padraig Harrington.
- Play was suspended for one hour and 58 minutes, from 12:57 p.m. ET to 2:55 p.m. ET due to course flooding.

#### Darren Clarke, 65-67-69-69 - 270 (-10)

- 53-year-old captures his first PGA TOUR Champions major (13<sup>th</sup> start).
  - Previous best finish in a senior major: 3<sup>rd</sup> (2021 Senior Open presented by Rolex)
  - Earned his fourth career PGA TOUR Champions victory.
    - Last victory: 2021 Sanford International.
  - Becomes the first Northern Irishman to win The Senior Open.
- Becomes only the fourth golfer to win both The Open Championship and The Senior Open, joining Bob Charles, Gary Player and Tom Watson.
- Improved to 3-for-4 converting leads/co-leads entering the final round.
  - Note: Improved to 1-for-1 converting leads/co-leads entering the final round of a 72-hole tournament
- Entered the week without a top-10 in his first 12 starts of the 2022 season on PGA TOUR Champions

#### **Other Notes**

.

- **Padraig Harrington** recorded 30 on the final nine to finish the final round with a 67, one shot off the lead.
  - Harrington won the 2022 U.S. Senior Open and finished runner-up at Regions Tradition and The Senior Open.
  - His 271 marks his lowest score in a PGA TOUR Champions major.
- Six players finished tied for third (-8).
  - Charles Schwab Cup leader Steven Alker recorded an even par 70 in the final round.
    - Alker now has nine top-3 finishes this season (13 starts).
  - **Doug Barron** and **Mauricio Molina** each tallied a 65 in the final round, the lowest rounds on the day.
    - Marks **Molina's** lowest-ever round at The Senior Open.

- Previous best: 67 in 2021 Senior Open (R2).
- Stands at the lowest-ever round in a PGA TOUR Champions major by **Barron** and tied for his fifth-lowest ever round on PGA TOUR Champions.
  - Previous best: 66 at Regions Tradition (R4).
  - Lowest round from Barron since registering a 64 at 2022 Mitsubishi Electric Championship (R3).
- **Paul Broadhurst** registered his best finish at a PGA TOUR Champions major since 2019 Senior Open.
- Ernie Els matched his best ever finish in a PGA TOUR Champions major.
  - Also: 2022 Regions Tradition and 2022 Bridgestone SENIOR PLAYERS Championship.
- **Thongchai Jaidee** recorded his best career finish in a PGA Tour Champions major.
  - Previous best: T4 2022 U.S. Senior Open.
- Four-time Senior Open champion **Bernhard Langer** recorded a 71 in the final round, finishing the tournament at T12 (-4).
- Reigning Senior Open champion **Stephen Dodd** registered a 73 in the final round, finishing the tournament at T47 (+5).
- Carlos Franco recorded a hole-in-one on hole No. 8 with a 6 iron from 175 yards.
