Things to Know

• Charles Schwab No. 5 **Miguel Angel Jimenez** birdied his final four holes en route to 5-under 67 and the solo first-round lead at the TimberTech Championship.

Miguel Angel Jimenez, 36-31 - 67 (-5)

Charles Schwab Cup standings - Start: 5th / Projected: 3rd

- This is his 15th time leading/co-leading after the first round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Is 5-for-14 converting those into victories
- Seeks his fourth win of the season (22nd start)
 - Would match Steve Stricker (4) and Steven Alker (4) for the most wins by any player this season on PGA TOUR Champions
- 58-year-old seeks his 14th win on PGA TOUR Champions (136th start)
 - Would move into T17 on the all-time wins list
 - Would move into T3 on the all-time wins list by active players, along with Fred Couples (14) and behind Bernhard Langer (43) and Jay Haas (18)
- Making his sixth start at the TimberTech Championship, his best finish is T2 (2021)
 - o Today's 67 is his lowest first-round score at this event
- Matched the highest first-round score to lead any PGA TOUR Champions event this season

Charles Schwab Cup Playoffs Implications

After Sunday's final round, the Top 36 players in the standings will qualify for the Charles Schwab Cup Championship. After the first round of the TimberTech Championship, **Tom Pernice Jr.** is projected to move into the Top 36.

Other Notes

- 2015 champion Paul Goydos is T2 after posting 4-under 68. The 58-year-old seeks his sixth win on PGA TOUR Champions (186th start).
 - o Last win: 2017 3M Championship
 - Best finish in 2022: T4 (KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship)
- Rod Pampling opened with 4-under 68 and sits T2. The 53-year-old seeks his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (60th start)
 - o Last win: 2021 Boeing Classic
 - o Best finish in 2022: T3 (Regions Tradition)
- 2017 champion Scott McCarron sits T4 at 3-under, along with Robert Karlsson and Tom Pernice Jr.
- Charles Schwab Cup leader and defending champion **Steven Alker** sits T7 after opening with 2-under 70. He is currently projected to retain his lead and extend it to 812,352 points over No. 2 **Padraig Harrington** (T23).
- Two-time TimberTech Championship winner **Bernhard Langer** (2010, 2019) sits T7 after shooting 2-under 70.
- Charles Schwab No. 4 Jerry Kelly carded 1-under 71 and sits T17.
- Vijay Singh withdrew during the first round (foot).
