Things to Know

• 65-year-old **Bernhard Langer** bettered his age with 9-under 63 to take a one-stroke lead over **Paul Goydos** entering the final round of the TimberTech Championship.

Bernhard Langer, 70-63 - 133 (-11)

Charles Schwab Cup standings - Start: 7th / Projected: 6th

- 65-year-old shot his age or better for the sixth time on PGA TOUR Champions
 - o His fourth time this season
 - His third time as a 65-year-old (since August 27, 2022)
- This was his low 18-hole score of the season (60th round)
- With a win on Sunday, he would extend his record as the oldest winner in PGA TOUR Champions history at 65 years, 2 months, 10 days
 - o He was 64 years, 5 months, 24 days when he won the 2022 Chubb Classic
- Seeks his 44th win on PGA TOUR Champions (315th start)
 - o Currently ranks second all-time behind Hale Irwin (45)
- Seeks his second win of the season (21st start)
 - Won the Chubb Classic in February
 - o Would become the seventh multi-time winner this season on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Would be his 13th multi-win season on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Note: 2022 is his 15th season since joining PGA TOUR Champions
 - Would be his 10th consecutive multi-win season
- This is his 44th time leading/co-leading entering the final round on PGA TOUR Champions
 - Is 27-for-43 converting those into victories
- Will play in the last group of the final round for the fourth time this season
 - Is 1-for-3 converting those into victories

- Making his 15th start at the TimberTech Championship, he has two wins (2010, 2019), among five top-3s and nine top-10s
 - o Today's 63 is his lowest 18-hole score at the TimberTech Championship (41st round)
 - Note: All previous TimberTech Championships were held at The Old Course at Broken Sound
- The Boca Raton resident seeks his ninth win in the state of Florida on PGA TOUR Champions
 - o His eight wins in Florida are his most in any state on the Champions Tour

Charles Schwab Cup Playoffs Implications

After Sunday's final round, the Top 36 players in the standings will qualify for the Charles Schwab Cup Championship. After the second round of the TimberTech Championship, **Joe Durant** and 2017 Charles Schwab Cup champion **Kevin Sutherland** are projected to move into the Top 36.

Other Notes

- 2015 champion **Paul Goydos** carded 6-under 66 and sits in second at 10-under. The 58-year-old seeks his sixth win on PGA TOUR Champions (186th start).
 - With a win on Sunday, he would snap a winless streak of 5 years and 3 months (or 1,918 days), dating back to the 2017 3M Championship
 - o Best finish in 2022: T4 (KitchenAid Senior PGA Championship)
- Rod Pampling posted bogey-free 3-under 69 and sits in third at 7-under. The 53-year-old seeks his second win on PGA TOUR Champions (60th start).
 - o Last win: 2021 Boeing Classic
 - Best finish in 2022: T3 (Regions Tradition)
- Five players are T4 at 6-under, including Charles Schwab Cup leader and defending champion **Steven Alker**, 2020 TimberTech Championship winner **Darren Clarke**, **Stephen Ames**, **Thongchai Jaidee** and **Joe Durant**.
 - Alker is currently projected to extend his lead in the Charles Schwab Cup standings to 830,528 points over No. 2 Padraig Harrington (T9).
- First-round leader and Charles Schwab No. 5 Miguel Angel Jimenez carded even-par 72 and sits T9 at 5-under.
- Charles Schwab No. 4 **Jerry Kelly** is T16 at 2-under.
