


**Extended forecast** – A weakening cold front will push towards Savannah on Saturday with a few showers and embedded T-storms expected. Precipitation chances will be capped at 30% since the bulk of the activity should fall apart before reaching the golf course. This front will stall out over Georgia on Sunday with an upper-level disturbance tracking along it. Showers and embedded T-storms could become better organized near Savannah by Sunday afternoon, however models are struggling with the exact location of the front. Given the uncertainty, precipitation chances for Sunday will be kept at 30%.
