**Today** – A stalled out front will remain active over northern Georgia, however these showers/T-storms are expected to remain 50-100 miles W and NW of the golf course much of the day. After 4pm, some of this activity may start to drift towards Savannah so a 20-25% chance for showers/T-storms will be included in the forecast. Southerly winds will increase by the afternoon with gusts of 15-20 mph possible. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.15". **Sunrise: 7:20am / Sunset: 7:39pm**

**Tomorrow** – A stalled out front over northern Georgia will begin to sink southward during the day Monday. This frontal boundary likely remains active, with clusters of showers/T-storms continuing along the front. Some of this activity should move into the Savannah area Monday afternoon but potentially in a weakening state. Given this, the forecast will keep shower/T-storm chances in the 20-40% range. Southwest winds will become breezy with gusts in the 20-25 mph range. Forecast rainfall: Less than 0.25". **Sunrise: 7:19am / Sunset: 7:40pm**
