**Extended forecast** – Limited weather concerns through Friday night with warm and dry conditions remaining in place. A weakening cold front will approach Savannah on Saturday. This could bring some showers to the area, however most of this activity is expected to diminish. This front will stall out over Georgia on Sunday with an upper-level disturbance tracking along it. Showers activity could become better organized near Savannah Sunday afternoon with a low threat for T-storms as well.
