









Extended Forecast – A slight chance of tstorms will be in place tonight with partly cloudy skies developing overnight into tomorrow morning. Partly cloudy skies tomorrow will give way to mostly sunny skies Sunday into early next week. Peak heat index values will be in the 100F – 110F range during the afternoon hours over the weekend. The strongest winds of the period are expected tomorrow when afternoon gusts are expected to be around 25 mph out of the SSW.
