Winds increase from the east after 9am but will become variable and switch to westerly around 3pm. Westerly breezes gust up to 15-20 mph late. Highs reach near 87F this afternoon and lows tonight fall to 67F. **Rainfall: Up to 0.20"**.

Extended forecast – Saturday, a weakening cold front approaching the area will bring an isolated shower/t-storm threat, highest chance between 9am-1pm. Winds turn westerly on Saturday with gusts up to 18-22 mph in the afternoon. Sunday, slightly drier air moves in behind the cold front, but an isolated shower/t-storm still cannot be ruled out. Winds on Sunday will be northeasterly through the morning, turning more north to slightly northwest in the afternoon.
